- Perseid Meteor Shower is a spectacular sight in the August night sky. early mornings, after midnight but before damn with best viewing day on the 12th and 13th.

FOOD FACTS WINE

- The development of wine pre-dates any written history, but historians feel people picked grapes and stored them in pots. Over time, the juice at the bottom of the pot naturally fermented and created the flavorful drink.
- The oldest evidence of wine dates back to 6,000BC in the Caucasus region currently known as Geogia.



- China also claims a fermented drink around 7,000BC made from fermented rice, honey and fruit, though many historians do not classify this as wine.
- In early times, wine and other fermented drinks, were considered safer to drink than water, with many feeling this created the popularity and spread of wine around the world.
- During early Roman times, it was illegal for women to drink wine.
- Wine used to be kept in goatskin bags, until Sir Kenelm Digby invented a green glass bottle in the 1600's to prevent sunlight from causing the wine to go bad.
- It takes 600-800 grapes to make one bottle of wine.

- A single grape vine can produce enough grapes to make up to 10 bottles of wine.
- Fermentation involves adding yeast into the juice from the grapes, which converts the sugars to alcohol and carbon dioxide
