FOOD FACTS - STEAK SAUCE

- In 1824 Henderson William Brand, a chef to **King George IV** of the United Kingdom, created the original sauce on which A.1. is based.
- The term "A.1." originated as a ship insurance term in the UK to describe a "first rate" ship by Lloyd's of London.
- It went into commercial production under the Brand & Co. label in 1831, marketed as a condiment for "fish, meat and fowl".
- A.1. Sauce in the US includes some of the following ingredients: **raisin** paste, **vinegar**, crushed **orange** purée, dried **garlic** and **onions**, **spice** and **celery seed**.
- Worcestershire sauce was created in 1835 by chemists John Lea and William Perrins in Worcester city in Worcestershire, England. (Note the name Lea & Perrins as still a brand sold today.)
- The correct pronunciation is "wu'-ster-shire" sauce.
- Worcestershire Sauce includes some of the following ingredients: Vinegar, molasses and anchovies.
